# Gasoline Spills at Kinder Morgan South Carolina Pumping Station

Pipeline Spill Is Contained Within Plantation Pipe Line Facility

Gasoline spilled at a pipeline pumping station in western South Carolina on Monday afternoon, according to [Kinder Morgan Energy Partners](#), which owns the line.

The company didn't say how much gasoline was released, but said the spill is contained within the Plantation Pipe Line Co. facility in Anderson, South Carolina. There was no fire, but nearby residents were asked to shelter-in-place as a precautionary measure, the company said.

Plantation Pipe Line is operated by a subsidiary of Kinder Morgan, which owns a majority stake in the company. The pipeline runs from Louisiana to the Washington, D.C. area and transports about 600,000 barrels a day of gasoline, jet fuel, diesel and biodiesel, according to the company's website.
